Dispatch from the Courthouse



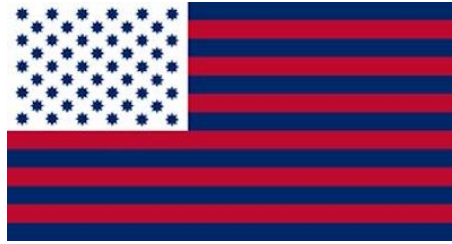
Our July speaker was Amanda Brantley, director for the House in the Horseshoe State

Historic Site. The house, built about 1772, is located in a bend on Deep River. Phillip Alston, a militia colonel, and several members of the county militia were attacked by Tories commanded by David Fanning. After several unsuccessful attempts to burn the house, Col. Alston was forced to surrender. In 1798 Gov. Benjamin Williams bought the house and plantation. North Carolina acquired the house in 1955.
